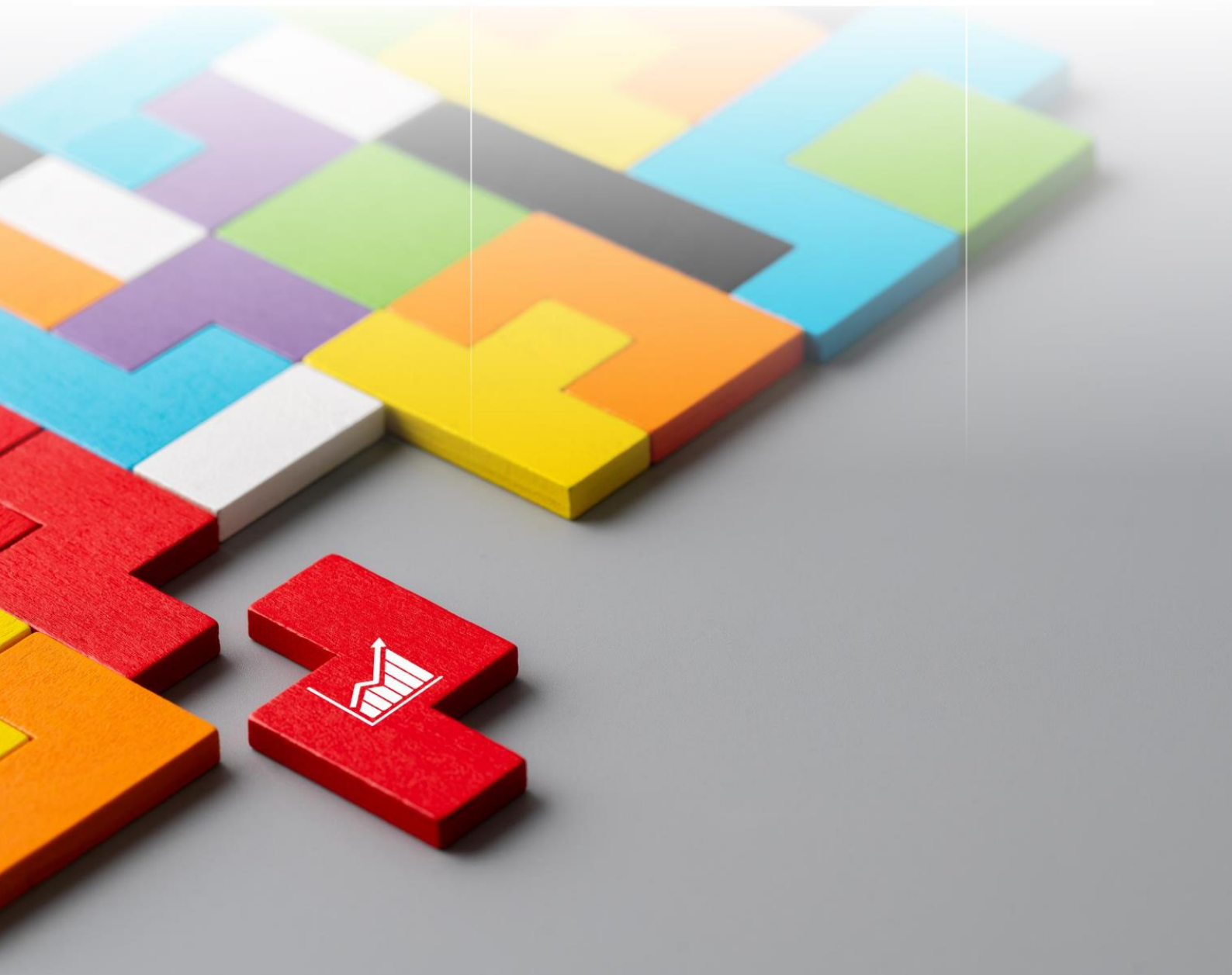

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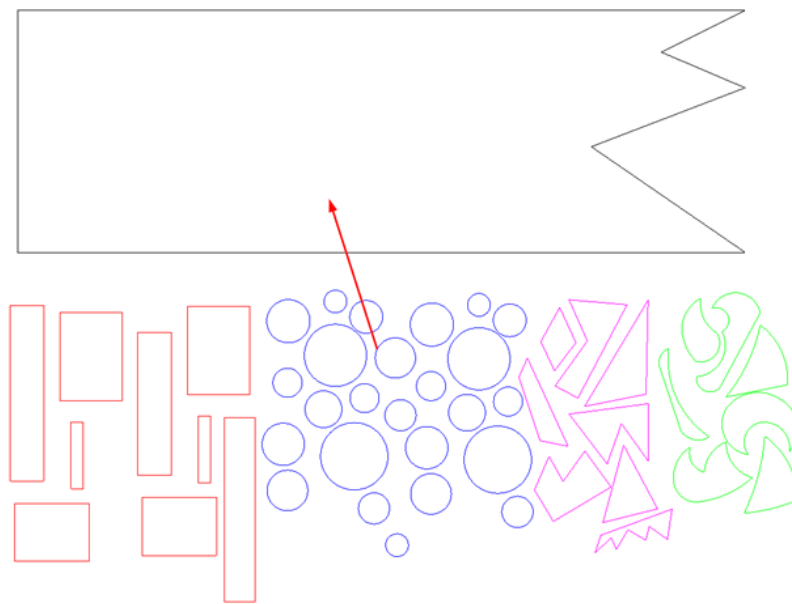
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ZWNesting

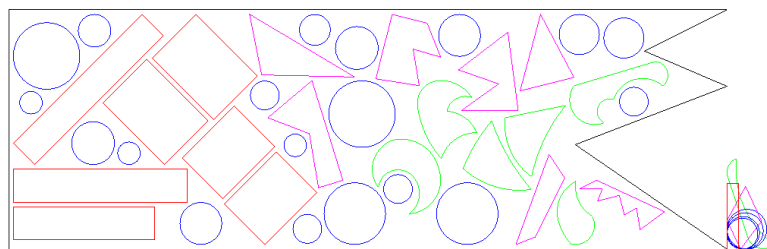
Arrange objects

With this command you can nest objects in an area of your choice.

1. The program will ask for an object – a polyline frame which represents an area on which elements will be placed.
2. Afterwards, the program will ask for elements from a drawing, which will be placed in the area.



3. Now the elements will be placed in the selected area:

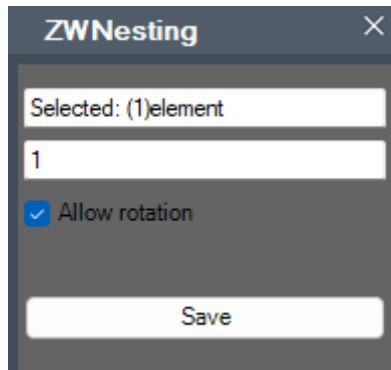


Objects that weren't fit into the selected area will be placed next to it. Furthermore, in the Command tab you will find information about the process of nesting.

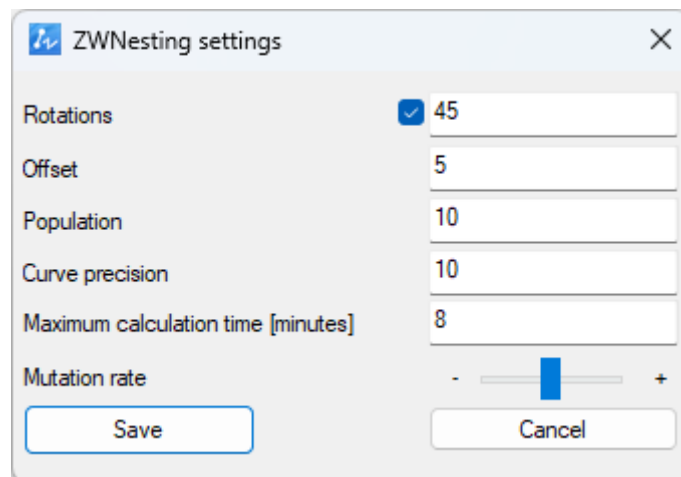
Panel

The program offers the possibility of choosing the number of copies for drawing elements. Select the ZWNesting panel, in the first window select the elements of the drawing, after that select the number of copies in the window below. If you don't choose the number of copies for the item, this element will be placed in the area in one copy. The selected elements could be blocked if the window Allow rotation is empty.



Settings

This commands opens a settings for the ZWNesting addon. Here are the options available to be changed:



- Rotations – Define a rotation angle of elements that are to be placed in a layout. The program will try to fit them by rotating them a number of times.
- Offset – Extra length between elements. Margins should be entered in the same units that the drawing is in. The program tries to place the elements as precisely as possible, in most cases the tolerance margin does not exceed $\pm 10\%$.

- Population – In order to maximize effectiveness of the program, there is an option to choose a number of iterations that will be completed. The program will try different layouts and will choose the one that has the best effect. If more iterations are set, the likelihood of a better result is high. However in order to create more iterations, more time is required. Smaller amount of iterations might be faster, but the result will not be as good as it could be with a higher iterations amount.
- Curve precision – every element, type of arc, circle or a polyline must be simplified in order to calculate it. Increasing this parameter will yield more precise results but the performance might suffer as the program will have to carry out more operations. Decreasing this parameter will improve loading times but results will not be as accurate.
- Maximum calculation time [minutes] – this setting limits the time of calculation process. If the calculation isn't finished around the set time, the process will end.
- Mutation rate - ZWNesting by default tries to fit all big elements at the beginning and then fit all the smaller ones. The user can change the default settings by moving the slider to the right, which priorities smaller elements from the bigger ones. Whereas moving the slide to the left will lower the priority of smaller elements. By default its set to the balanced state.

Activation

A trial period that lasts for 30 days with full functionality is available after installation of the application.

[Activation must be completed on an account with administrative privileges.](#)

Once the trial period of 30 days runs out, a licence will be needed in order to use the program. After receiving the payment, an e-mail with an activation code will be sent. Activation is available directly in ZWCAD or by using the function Activation from menu of the application. It is also possible to activate the program from its installation folder. By default located in:

C:\Szansa\Aktywator\2024\EN and run **Aktywator_2024.exe**.

In operating systems such as Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8 and Windows 10 it is necessary to right click on ZWCAD icon and select Run as Administrator.

Full licence code is only visible on the licence certificate that is sent out during completion of the order due to security reasons. Once Activator has been launched, the following window

will be displayed:

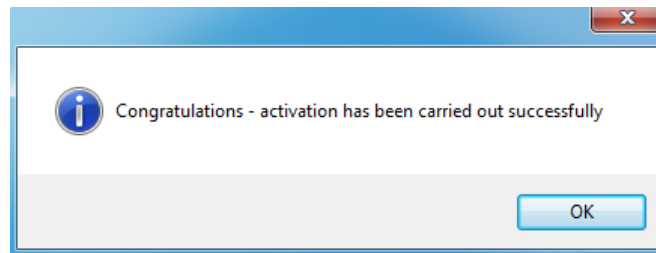
Please click on **Activate**.

Online activation


In the field **Activation code** please type in the information sent during realization of the order, afterwards click on **Activate**.

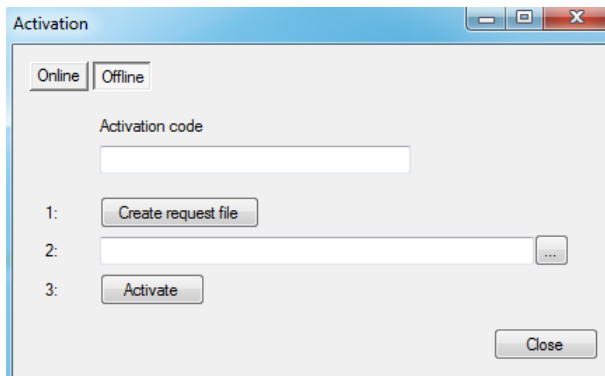
An information window will pop up confirming the activation.




Once ZWCAD is launched, all functions of the program should be loaded and available.

In the **Offline** tab  additional steps are required to complete the activation.




In the field **Activation code** please type in the information sent during realization of the order.




A screenshot of a software interface showing a text input field labeled 'Activation code' and a button labeled 'Activate' below it.

A screenshot of a button labeled '2: ...' with a small square icon containing three dots.

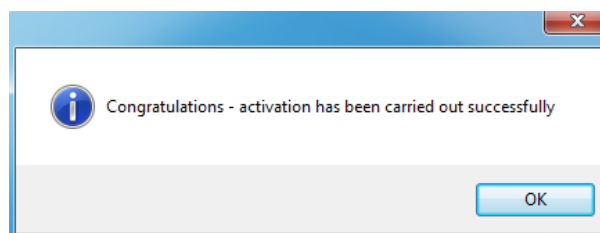
Response file needs to be saved on the computer and its localization needs to be determined by clicking on the following icon .

Manual menu load

After installing the overlay, it should load automatically after running ZWCAD 2024. The functions should be available and the toolbar with the icons should be displayed. If after running ZWCAD the overlay does not appear, please follow these steps:

- Run the command `_menuload`.
- Press the button and select the file `ZWNesting.cuix` located in `C:\Szansa\ZWNesting\2024\EN`. Confirm the file by clicking Add.
